
Sir/Madam,

In continuation to this office' Conditional LoP issued to you on 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2014 and with reference to MCI's letter No. 34(41) (E-28)/2014-Med./119363 dated 11.07.2014 and your compliance conveyed vide letter dated 07.07.2014 on the above subject, I am directed to inform that the compliance and details of Bank Guarantees have been taken on record and the conditions attached in conditional LoP dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2014 are hereby withdrawn in view of the compliance and Bank Guarantee received.

2. Accordingly, you are hereby allowed to establish the new medical college, **Viswabharathi Medical College & General Hospital at Kurnool by Viswabharathi Educational Society** for MBBS Course with annual admission capacity of **150 seats** for the academic year 2014-15 u/s 10 (A) of IMC Act, 1956 and as amended from time to time.

3. This permission of the Central Government for establishment of medical college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievements of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per the norms of Medical Council of India.
